Mr. Nikos Andreadakis is a Professor at the Department of Sciences of Preschool Education and Educational Design (T.E.P.A.E.S.) of the University of the Aegean, with subject "Educational Research & Evaluation".

His teaching and research interests focus on: educational evaluation, evaluation of educational work and teachers, effectiveness & evaluation of school units, evaluation of educational programs, student evaluation, school failure, quantitative and qualitative research methods, educational & social research design, applied descriptive & inferential statistics, etc.

He was initially faculty member at the Department of Primary Education of the University of Crete (1997-2013) and then at the T.E.P.A.E.S. of the University of the Aegean (2014 until today). He has taught and continues to teach in many postgraduate programs (Universities of Athens, Crete, Aegean etc.).

He has authored 3 books, edited 14 collective volumes or conference proceedings, authored 56 chapters in collective volumes, published 25 papers in conference proceedings and 30 articles in scientific journals, while he has participated in 25 research and evaluation programs – projects.

He has offered academic or administrative work to bodies in the academic and educational field, such as: member of the administrative board of the Quality Assurance Authority in Primary and Secondary Education of the Ministry of Education, member of the directors board of the Research and Studies Center of the University of Crete, Director or Deputy Director of Editorial Boards of scientific journals ("Educational Sciences", "Hellenic Review of Educational Evaluation", etc.). Finally, he was Head of the T.E.P.A.E.S. of the University of the Aegean (2018-2022).
